Cindy Chinn Brings Full Range of Her Work Together for First Comprehensive Exhibition

“Not Your Typical Artist” opens September 3 at Gallery 92 West in Fremont
FREMONT, Neb. — Nebraska artist Cindy Chinn will present *Not Your Typical Artist*, September 3 through 25, 2026, at Gallery 92 West in Fremont. The exhibition marks the first time the full range of Chinn’s artistic practice has been brought together in one comprehensive exhibition.

Known internationally for her intricate pencil micro-sculptures, Chinn’s work extends far beyond the miniature scale. The Fremont exhibition will introduce visitors to a much broader practice that includes reclaimed-material sculpture, metalwork, painting, glass, ceramics, assemblage, and large-scale sculpture.

Working from her studio in rural Chester Nebraska, Chinn has built a career around transforming familiar, overlooked, and discarded materials into unexpected works of art. Her practice moves easily between extremes of scale, from sculptures carved into the graphite of a pencil to substantial works fabricated from machinery, scrap metal, tools, and other everyday materials.

“I’ve always been curious about materials and what else they might become,” Chinn said. “This exhibition is exciting for me because people will finally be able to see these very different parts of my work together and, I hope, see the connection between them.”

The exhibition comes during an important period in Chinn’s career. In 2026, her pencil sculptures were represented by Post-American Fine Arts at Basel Social Club during Art Basel week in Switzerland. Her work has also been exhibited and collected internationally, while Chinn has continued to create from her studio in Chester, Nebraska.

While the individual works vary widely in medium, scale, and subject, a common thread runs throughout Chinn’s practice: curiosity, technical invention, storytelling, and the transformation of ordinary materials into something unexpected.

Not Your Typical Artist offers visitors a rare opportunity to experience that broader body of work in one place and to see the artistic practice behind the pencil sculptures for which Chinn first gained widespread attention. An opening reception will be held **Thursday, September 3, from 5 to 7 p.m.** at Gallery 92 West. Cindy Chinn will be present, and the reception is free and open to the public.

The exhibition continues through **September 25, 2026**.

About Cindy Chinn

Cindy Chinn is an interdisciplinary artist based in Chester, Nebraska. Her practice spans pencil micro-sculpture, reclaimed-material and metal sculpture, painting, glass, ceramics, murals, assemblage, and large-scale work. Across media, her work is characterized by technical experimentation, shifts in scale, narrative detail, and a fascination with transforming ordinary materials into unexpected forms.

Chinn's work has been exhibited and collected internationally. In 2026, her pencil sculpture was represented by Post-American Fine Arts at Basel Social Club during Art Basel week in Switzerland.
